The before and after picture shows a complete transformation from February to November with our first Pond, T1's full harvest recorded a survival of 93% and a total tonnage of 7000KG.

"DEMAND FOR TIGER PRAWN"

As we head into the festive seasons and with the promise of a working vaccine, we are seeing a slight increase in the Tiger Prawn pricing.

"China has also witnessed an obvious increase in shrimp prices. Statistics from the October point to an increase of about 3,000 yuan to 4,000 yuan per ton (\$427.98-\$57.64/ton USD) for its domestic shrimp, and local farmers are holding shrimps longer, waiting for higher prices. The increase is between USD \$0.40 to \$0.50 per kg for those imports from Ecuador, Vietnam, Malaysia and India.

Its price increase is mainly a result from shrimp shortages, which in turn is caused by several factors, for instance Covid-19 pandemic and also China is importing more to bridge the gap between rising demand and inadequate supply. Hence, with Chinese New Year approaching by the early of February, higher shrimp import is likely to continue".





"LAND AQUISITION FROM GORVERMENT SECTOR"

Due to the 3rd wave of the pandemic, we are experiencing some delays on land acquisition from the Government. This is understandable as most of the appointments or meetings are pushed out for social distancing purposes.
