SHORTAGE OF WORKERS

UPCOMING MOVE BY FDI...

Bagan Datuk farm will have its first cycle harvest in coming month and we estimated that we are able to exceed a harvest of survival of **90%** and a total tonnage of **20000KG** for **5** ponds at Bagan Datuk farm.
