We will be doing partial harvest on **5 ponds in June**, totaling **4,500 kg** with a market value of **RM150.000**.

This success again fortified the effectiveness of our SOP and operation team. Great Job too all of the guys involved!

WATER INTAKE PROBLEM

One of our biggest challenges is to get enough pristine water to support our continuous farming cycle. We've encountered sea water shortage problem in several farms.

But thanks to our operation team and their out-of-the-box thinking, we were able to counter this problem by building a small canal and channelling water from further out in the ocean.





UPCOMING MOVE BY FDI..

We target to stock our black tiger shrimp in our Sanglang pond which is **SL2,SL3,SL7** in the beginning of the month. We estimated that we are able to exceed a harvest of survival by **90%** and increasing our revenue by **15%**.
